What is the Project?

Leeds Art Gallery offers free pick-up activities for family audiences during the school holidays.

We would like to involve a team of volunteers to assist families to engage with our offer.

The volunteers will be supporting the Learning Officer and the gallery team during busy holiday periods to ensure we reach out to as many families as possible.

Gain experience working with gallery interpretation and audiences.

Assist families to creatively engage with art in a gallery.

Gain experience in enriching activities for family audiences using your interests and skills.

What's involved?

Providing a warm welcome for families.

Assisting family audience activity engagement where appropriate.

Recording participation and feedback.

Supporting social media communications.

Attending relevant training and inductions.

The role will suit people who.....are creative, enthusiastic, reliable and trustworthy and have very good communication skills. Ideally you will enjoy working as part of a team and be keen to learn and gain experience. You should be able to work both with and without supervision when required, and whilst you must feel comfortable working with young people, you will not be left to supervise them alone. All volunteers should be willing to abide by the Council's code of conduct. No qualifications are required as training will be given.
