



**Minutes of the RKLTY Youth Board
held via TEAMS
on Monday 14th February 2022, commencing 12.30 pm**

Action

Mr Sheriff and Mr Tulley welcomed everyone to the first meeting of the Red Kite Youth Board. They presented to all about the story of the Red Kite and its origins, along with an overview of the Trust confirming there are 13 schools, with 1,200 members of staff and 8,500 children and young people. They spoke about the Trust Mission, Values and Goals. They explained about the make-up of the Youth Board and its remit, along with how the Board would work including frequency of meetings and having Chairs and Vice Chairs. They confirmed that the members of the Youth Board will be the ones setting the agendas.

Suggested topics for each meeting could include the environment, sustainability, being net zero by 2030, wellbeing and mental health, technology and learning, Red Kite competitions, concerts, sports days etc., and having guest speakers.

Ideas from the Youth Board

HGS - Interschool collaboration – activities, competitions between schools.

Meadowfield – Milk straws, find a different way to reduce plastic waste. Look at bins on the beach to protect animals. Raise more money i.e., table top sales, raise money for trips.

TLA – Lack of computers and online learning, not everyone has the internet and resources to go online.

Crawshaw – Online learning – technology in school, look at funding to hand out laptops. Collaboration, getting to know each other's schools. Curriculum to help those who do not have access to other courses.

Coppice Valley – Interschool fund raising groups for local communities. Joint charity – doing activities together. This to be included on the Agenda.

Whitkirk – Allergies – look at school food nutrition. Promote Health and wellbeing, make sure everyone is ok and spot when someone isn't and do something about it.

TLA – Social injustice, poorer households (rather than charity).

Rossett Acre – Work on sustainability, raise money for solar panels look at recycling bins. **ACTION** – Invite Miss Shuttleworth to future meeting.
